Peninsula Competition hosts the second annual Mini-Camp to blow the cobwebs of summer away. Itinerary: The plan is to depart for Norway Mt. at 5:00 PM Thanksgiving Day (after the Lions lose). We will meet in the Target parking lot in Hartland. We will then drive straight through to slope-side condo lodgings at the Norway Mountain. Breakfasts and lunch will be at the condo. Friday dinner will be the traditional Thanksgiving meal at race director's Ron Lawrence's home. Saturday night meal is Pizza night! We will race a dual slalom Sunday morning and after lunch we will depart for home. ETA is approximately 9PM Sunday Evening.

Please pack light as space is limited and we are only going for three days. Normal race gear including your GS suit would be expected. Helmets and goggles and proper outerwear will be necessary to enjoy and garner full benefit from the camp.

Costs: The cost for the Mini-Camp is \$325.00 this includes three nights of Slope-side lodging at Norway Mt., all meals BLD-Friday, BLD-Saturday, BL-Sunday (in transit meals/snacks going up and back are racer responsibility.) , all coaching, three days lift fees, transportation and special Minicamp Turkey T-shirt.
